Ephesians 2:19-20 Activities

A. Take a few moments to ponder what your life would be like without the Lord's prophets and apostles on the earth today. Imagine life without their authority from the Lord, and their inspired teachings, guidance, and Christlike example. Write in your study journal how life would be different and what you would miss.

B. Later in his epistle, Paul mentioned additional blessings that come through prophets, apostles, and other Church leaders. Read Ephesians 4:11–14 and consider marking these blessings. It may be helpful to know that an evangelist is a patriarch, and a pastor refers to a leader of a congregation, like a stake or district president, bishop or branch president. Write down one or two ways you have experienced these blessings.

C. Select one or two topics in For the Strength of Youth: A Guide for Making Choices (booklet, 2022). Write down specific ways this guidance from the Lord's apostles and prophets has helped you.

D. Think about how prophets and apostles have helped you come to know the Savior and become more like Him. Write your thoughts in your study journal.
